SUBJECT: Route P59 Bridge Replacement

On May 17, 2010 the bridge replacement project will begin on Route P-59 (a.k.a. Quail Avenue) over the quarry haul road adjacent to Gypsum City OHV Park. The contract allows 70 working days to complete the project.

The project will require Route P-59 to be closed to through traffic between U.S. Highway 20 and Route D-20 and a detour to be established utilizing U.S. Highway 169/U.S. Highway 20 at Exit 121 and Iowa Highway 17/U.S. Highway 20 at Exit 136 as shown on the attached map.

NO THROUGH TRAFFIC WILL BE ALLOWED ON ROUTE P-59 BETWEEN U.S. HIGHWAY 20 AT EXIT 124 AND ROUTE D-20 (A.K.A. 5TH AVENUE SOUTH).

In order to minimize the impact to your business and any of your suppliers or customers, we urge you to notify them of this detour so they can plan their route accordingly.
